**FINANCIAL BAILOUT PACKAGE JUST BEGINNING OF REFORM EFFORT, ACCORDING
TO PARTNERSHIP FOR PUBLIC SERVICE**

***Roadmap to Reform Report Lays Out Critical Government Management Reform Recommendations
for the Next President, Treasury Officials, and Transition Teams***

WASHINGTON – On Wednesday, October 1, the Partnership for Public Service will release ***Roadmap to Reform: A Management Framework for the Next Administration*** in concert with key government reform groups including the National Academy of Public Administration, the Council for Excellence in Government, the Coalition for Effective Change, the IBM Center for The Business of Government, CNA, and the Center for the Study of the Presidency. The report sets forth consensus recommendations for the next President, transition teams, and Treasury officials.

“The bailout package is the beginning, not the end, of addressing our nation’s financial crisis. Key to success will be the government’s operational management of the bailout in the months to come,” said Max Stier, Partnership for Public Service President. “There’s nothing like a crisis to help people realize that having an effective government matters.”
