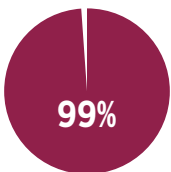

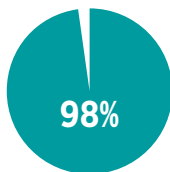
Seminar participants will:

- Receive after-class support from Partnership staff to ensure implementation

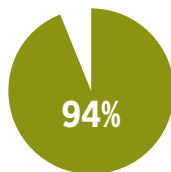
